PhD in Cultural Studies

1. Vacancies

- Number of vacancies for the academic year 2023/2024: **20**
Vacancies for national candidates or equivalent: 12
Vacancies for international candidates: 8
(Vacancies can be moved from national or international candidates as long as they do not exceed the total)
- Minimum number of registrations for the curricular course: 10

2. Access Conditions

Admitted applications shall correspond to the following requirements::

- Have a Master Degree or a legal equivalent degree in Social Sciences, Humanities of Arts
- To be in possession of a graduation, and be the holders of an academic curriculum recognized adequate for the accomplishment of a PhD Program by the Scientific Committee of the Institute of Social Sciences, University of Minho;
- To be the holders of an academic, scientific and professional curriculum recognized as appropriate to accomplish the PhD Program by the Scientific Committee of the Institute of Social Sciences, University of Minho.

Note: The recognition referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3, only grants the access to the PhD Program, and it does not confer the equivalence to the master degree (or any other degree) to its holder.

3. Application Periods

1st period: from 11th to 20th April¹

2nd period: from 23th May to 10 July (leftover vacancies)

3rd period: from 5th to 8th September (leftover vacancies)

5. Documents

- Documents proving the candidate's degrees (a copy of the certificate/s, together with a detailed list of the achieved courses and their final marks). In case of not making proof of academic degree final classification (as above indicated), it will be considered 10 values as final grade.
- Detailed *Curriculum Vitae*;
- A motivation letter, outlining reasons, interests and expectations regarding the PhD program;
- Other documents that might be relevant for the application;

¹ We advise this application period to foreign candidates, concerning the visa process, if needed.

- Application fee: 40€, not refundable.

Note: In case of doubt, regarding the elements relevant to the selection process, University of Minho may request additional information from the applicant or documents' confirmation.

6. Selection Criteria

Applications will be selected by the PhD in Communication Sciences Committee, taking into account the following topics:

- Academic, scientific and professional curriculum analysis taking into account the following parameters:

1. Academic Curriculum (weight 50%)

- 1.1 Degree
- 1.2 Graduate studies
- 1.3 Master's 1
- 1.4 PhD
- 1.5 Short courses

2. Scientific Curriculum (weight 25%)

- 2.1 Publications
- 2.2 Projects
- 2.3 Others

3. Professional Curriculum ((weight 25%))

- 3.1. In the course area
- 3.2. Others

- Articulation with ongoing research projects from the Communication and Society Research Centre (www.cecs.uminho.pt) or Centre for Humanistic Research Studies ([CEHUM \(uminho.pt\)](http://CEHUM(uminho.pt))) of the University of Minho;
