PhD in **History** | Doctoral Programme

1. Specialization Areas

Students will be able to carry out their research in the areas of Art History; History of Portuguese Discoveries and Expansion; Modern History; Medieval History; Early Modern History; Theory and Methods, Historical Demography, Heritage.

2. Vacancies

- Number of vacancies for the academic year 2021/2022: **25**
Vacancies for national candidates or equivalent: 15
Vacancies for international candidates: 10
(Vacancies can be moved from national or international candidates as long as they do not exceed the total)
- Minimum number of registrations for the curricular course: 5

3. Access Conditions

Admitted applications shall correspond to the following requirements:

- Have a Master Degree or a legal equivalent degree;
- To be in possession of a graduation, and be the holders of an academic curriculum recognized adequate for the accomplishment of a PhD Program by the committee of the Department of History, and the Scientific Committee of the Institute of Social Sciences, University of Minho;
- To be the holders of an academic, scientific and professional curriculum recognized as appropriate to accomplish the PhD Program by the Committee of the Department of History and the Scientific Commission of the Institute of Social Sciences, University of Minho.

Note: The recognition referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3, only grants the access to the PhD Program, and it does not confer the equivalence to the master degree (or any other degree) to its holder.

4. Application Periods

1st period: from 24th March to 28th April¹

2nd period: from 24th May to 7th July (leftover vacancies)

3rd period: from 30th August to 3rd September (leftover vacancies)

6. Documents

- Documents proving the candidate's degrees (a copy of the certificate/s, together with a detailed list of the achieved courses and their final marks). In case of not making proof of academic degree final classification (as above indicated), it will be considered 10 values as final grade.
- Detailed *Curriculum Vitae*;
- A motivation letter, outlining reasons, interests and expectations regarding the PhD program;
- Other documents that might be relevant for the application;
- Application fee: 40€, not refundable.

Note: In case of doubt, regarding the elements relevant to the selection process, University of Minho may request additional information from the applicant or documents' confirmation.

7. Selection Criteria

Curricular evaluation and interview (as an additional criterion to be decided by the PhD Direction).

Academic, scientific and professional curriculum analysis taking into account the following parameters*:
